E-bikes and Electric scooters use large lithium-ion

batteries which can present a risk or serious fire

or explosion in certain circumstances.

Follow these 5 steps when purchasing, charging and storing your electric scooter or e-bike to reduce fire risks:

- Do your research: Only buy an e-bike, electric scooter, charger or battery from a known seller and check product reviews.
- Read and follow the manufacturer's instructions for charging and using e-bikes and electric scooters.
- Not all e-bikes and e-scooter batteries and chargers are compatible or safe when used together. Check and only use the manufacturers recommended battery and charger.
- Always charge in a safe place without blocking exits, and always unplug your charger when you have finished charging. Fit smoke alarms in the area where you charge your batteries at home.
- Never attempt to modify or tamper with your battery.
